- Design aesthetics for creating visually appealing presentations
- Ethically sourcing and using multimedia content such as images, audio, and video
- Hands-on practice in creating multimedia projects using digital tools and software

Project Development and Presentation

- Applying learned skills to develop and finalize projects or presentations
- Presenting projects or presentations to peers for feedback and discussion
- Reflecting on the overall learning experience and identifying areas for improvement
